ORDER

As per the Government Order read as first paper above, Essentiality Certificate (in Form 4 excluding the last para of the proforma prescribed by the Central Council of Indian Medicine) was issued to the Chairman, P.N.Panicker Souhruda Trust for starting an Ayurveda College at Kanhangadu, Kasaragod District subject to the condition that they should execute an agreement stating that they would abide by the rules and regulations issued by the State Government in this regard from time to time. In the letter read as second paper above the Central Council of Indian Medicine has pointed out among other things that the No Objection Certificate of the State Government is not as per proforma prescribed by them. In the letter read as third paper above, the Chairman, P.N.Panicker Souhruda Trust has requested Government to issue revised Essentiality Certificate in Form No. 4 as prescribed by CCIM.

2. Having examined the matter in detail Government are pleased to issue Essentiality Certificate as appended to this order in

Form No.4 prescribed by CCIM to the Chairman, P.N.Panicker Souhruda Trust, Kanhangadu, Kasaragode for starting an Ayurveda College at Kanhangad subject to the condition that the institution will execute an agreement stating that the institution will abide by the decisions taken by the State Government with regard to admission of students, reservation, fees etc. from time to time.

The Director of Ayurveda Medical Education will ensure the execution of the agreement aforesaid and report the matter to Government.

8. How the establishment of Ayurveda Medical College would resolve the problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personnel in the State and improve the availability of such medical man power in the State:

The Ayurveda system of education is gaining popularity and acceptance all over the world. European countries and US are anxiously looking forward to India for the import of Ayurvedic concepts and Man power. There is increasing demands for qualified Ayurvedic Medical practitioners in domestic sector also. But with the present availability of qualified hands in Ayurveda in Kerala these demands cannot be satisfied. These problems can be solved to some extent by the establishment of an Ayurveda College by P.N.Panicker Souhruda Trust.

9. The restrictions imposed by the State Government, if any, on students who are domiciled in the state from obtaining admissions in the State be specified:

Admission to BAMS course in Government and Aided Ayurveda Colleges are restricted to candidates domiciled in the Kerala State only. The admission shall be based on the rules and regulations issued by Government from time to time

10. Full justification for establishment of the Ayurveda College:

The Ayurveda system of education is gaining popularity and acceptance all over the world. European countries and US are anxiously looking forward to India for the import of Ayurvedic concepts and Man power. There is increasing demands for qualified Ayurvedic Medical practitioners in domestic sector also. But with the present availability of qualified hands in Ayurveda in Kerala these demands cannot be satisfied. These problems can be solved to some extent by the establishment of an Ayurveda College by P.N.Panicker Souhruda Trust.

11. Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani Doctors-population ratio to be achieved : 1:1500


The Chairman, P.N.Panicker Souhruda Trust has applied for establishment of an Ayurveda College at Kanhangad in Kasaragode. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Kerala has decided to issue no objection certificate to the applicant for starting the Ayurveda College.

It is certified that

- a. The applicant owns a building of 3000 sq.ft. plinth area for running a hospital.
- b. It is desirable in the public interest to start an Ayurveda College, at Kanhangad in Kasaragod.
- c. Starting of an Ayurveda College at Kanhangad by P.N.Panicker Souhruda Trust, Kanhangad, Kerala is feasible.

It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per norms of the Central Council of Indian Medicine is available with the proposed Ayurveda college. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Ayurveda/Siddha/Unani/Tibb college as per Central Council of Indian Medicine norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.
